In addition, Members will be provided with a monthly update of outcomes of meeting that have been held and further meetings that are scheduled for the month ahead so they are more aware of work ongoing across all Scrutiny and Governance Committees and can inform the public. Furthermore, we will be promoting Scrutiny and other democratic meetings on social media and monitoring viewership of meeting recordings. Other engagement methods to enhance existing arrangements have included shared updates at ward meetings that included a session on budget consultation. The participation strategy is an evolving document that continues to be developed over time to increase engagement and participation.
